FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR WAHCONAH SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECT

An Updated Message from the School Building Committee

The School Building Committee has continued to meet regularly. The focus of the SBC has been on recommending the language of the vote for the feasibility study as well as getting information about the upcoming vote to the constituents of the seven member towns. The language as recommended was agreed to in a vote taken by the CBRSD School Committee on January 26th. The recommendation to School Committee on the language for the feasibility study was determined by considering three main questions:

- What grade span to study? It has been determined the vote will be to study a 9-12 building.
- What type of building project to study; renovation or rebuild? It has been determined the feasibility study being voted on will look at both options.
- Cost of the Feasibility Study? The Feasibility Study being voted on is estimated to cost \$850,000 of which a percentage (50-54%) will be reimbursed by MSBA.

The vote for the Feasibility Study will be done by popular vote, requiring a favorable vote from the majority of voters from all seven towns to pass. The votes will take place in each of the seven towns on. **Saturday, April 8, 2017** (see below for locations). The estimated impact of the cost of the Feasibility Study to individual taxpayers can be found on the district website.

Parks Committee Meeting

April 5, 2017 at Town Park 6:30 PM and then it moves to the town hall at 7:00.

The Parks Committee has had some members for over 30 years! The Park is in need of a fresh group of interested towns people to introduce new ideas and new energy. Anyone interested is welcome to attend this meeting or contact Ed Bond at edb112@verizon.net.

Our schools are the most important civic institution binding our communities together. Educating and developing the next generation is our greatest responsibility as citizens. After ten years of petitioning for funds from the Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA) Central Berkshire has finally gotten on their list. This means that MSBA will fund more than half of the long overdue and badly needed upgrade of Wahconah.

- The first step is for a majority of the seven towns' voters to approve a Feasibility Study to determine the best way to address the deterioration of Wahconah's systems and its outdated and inadequate facilities. The vote will be held on April 8 at the Washington Town Hall from 10-4. For more information see the flier enclosed in today's TRACKS and go to www.cbrsd.org and take a virtual tour to see the sad shape of the school.
- MSBA will fund more than half of the study. Whatever plans are developed will need to be approved by both the School Committee and the voters.
- The Select Board strongly supports taking advantage of this opportunity and urges that you vote to approve the Feasibility Study.

Thanks to the voters who turned out for the March 20th Special Town Meeting to clean up some overdue bills and close out loans that are no longer needed.

Road & Bridge:

- The culvert at the top of Frost Road has been stabilized for two-way and through traffic; we are investigating the most cost-effective way of fixing it.
- We will be developing a design for the Middlefield Road Bridge and expect to have a new span in place before winter thanks to our Small Bridge grant of \$250,000.
- The Eden Glen project is finally getting underway; details and a construction schedule should be available this month.
- We are concerned that Washington Mountain Road is already showing signs of wear; DOT has not yet signed off on the project and we are documenting the deterioration and communicating both to DOT and the contractor.
- The Summit Hill Road bridge over the CSX tracks will be closed later this month and should reopen August 29. The Board will work with Hinsdale and DOT to ensure that the detour route is and remains acceptable.

It appears that MBI has finally decided to do their job and assist us in getting a high speed internet connection to all of our households. They are releasing funding appropriated over eight years ago. Our course of action now is to use the money to engage a design firm, most likely in coordination with our sister communities in Wired West. Construction will proceed as soon as humanly possible.
