July 4th - Independence Day July 21st - National Ice Cream Day July 28th - Parents Day!!! We begin the new Fiscal Year with almost all of the same elected and appointed staff as we had a year ago. This kind of continuity helps everyone do their jobs more effectively and efficiently to the benefit of the whole Town.

The Mapleview property was sold at auction to Jayne Pytko on June 1 for \$5000 and is now back on the tax rolls.

Several of our residents have written us concerned about the condition of Washington Mountain Road. We have forwarded these concerns to our state representatives and the Department of Transportation.

- Although the Board has managed to keep the rehabilitation of Washington Mountain Road on the state project list, we recognize that the way the process works it is unlikely to be funded any time soon. We have:
 - Lobbied for a change in the process;
 - Asked DOT for special funding;
 - Asked our state representatives for special funding.
- Meanwhile the Board is considering imposing a weight limit on the road to limit further deterioration, imposing a very low speed limit to safeguard vehicles, or even closing the road to through traffic entirely. Please let us know whether you agree with and support these measures.

- Finish the work on the auditorium wall.
- Get weight limits on Blotz Road.
- Get some partners for a solar energy project on the landlocked Town property on the other side of the CSX tracks that abut the Town Park.
