Thanks to all who came out to vote in the State Primary on Tuesday, September 9. Of our 421 registered voters, we had 80 ballots cast; a 19% voter turnout. This is slightly above the state average of 17%

The general election will be on Tuesday, November 4 with polling hours from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Please come out and vote.

If you are not currently registered to vote in Washington or need to change your party enrollment, the deadline to do this for the general election is Wednesday, October 15. A voter registration session will be held on this date from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM and again from 7:00 PM to 8:00 PM.

A letter from the Selectboard

To our fellow Washington residents:

October 2014

Congratulations to two Town employees: Dave Fish for being named a "Roads Scholar" by the Baystate Roads Program by completing 7 workshops to enhance his skills, and our newest Assessor, Greg Viner, for acing his accreditation exam.

Two of Washington's three signature events were held last month, the Hilltown Hoot on September 7 and the 105th annual Sons & Daughters reunion on September 14; the John F. X. Keator Pumpkin Walk will start at 6 pm on Friday October 24 at the Town Park. Taken together these unique events celebrate our Town and are possible only because of the hard work and volunteerism of our citizens.

- One memorable moment at the Hoot came from Arlo Guthrie who pointed out that in many places in the world people are afraid to even go out in public and that what we have in Washington should be valued and appreciated. Thanks to the three generations of Guthries who entertained us!
- The Sons & Daughters witnessed a changing of the guard: Judge Sacco stepped down after more than 15 years as Chairman and Carol Kennedy stepped down as Treasurer. Dick Grillon and Ellen Bond will replace them and Ken Nonken will backfill Dick as Vice-Chair. Special thanks to Trish Drugmand for stepping up to prepare the food when the expected caterer was not available.

Tennessee Gas Pipeline (TGP) has filed a preliminary notification with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) for their proposed natural gas pipeline. The initial plan for the 36" pipeline does not call for a compressor station in Western Mass, but does talk about a metering facility in Dalton and adds an otherwise undefined "Pittsfield loop" of 1.8 miles of 12' pipe. The formal application will be made September 2015 with construction planned between January 2017 and November 2019. Construction dates for Berkshire County were not broken out. The FERC process is fully open to the public. The 14 page TGP application and a 2 page "fact sheet" are posted on the Town's website.

Dr. Putnam, our new Superintendent of Schools, is meeting with students, parents groups and all seven towns to gather information from which he will develop goals for the District. We welcomed him to the 9/15 Select Board meeting during which he listened to many ideas from attendees. We look forward to learning his plans - and appreciate his work as Hoot Emcee and musician!

Our tax rate for 2015 has been certified at \$13.41- two cents below last year's.

Free flu shots will be available at the Town Hall from 4:30 to 7:00 on Monday October 6.

Anyone who is using Airbnb or any similar service to rent out a house or room for short periods of time is reminded that Board of Health permits are required. If you are renting out your property please contact Jodi Hostetter.

Highway updates:

- We received many responses to our RFP to replace culverts on Lower Valley, Cross Place and Lower Sargent. We expect to have a proposal for our voters next month.
- No word yet from FEMA on grant funding for Depot Brook/Eden Glen; the National Park Service will do a site visit next week.
